

Privacy Policy

OptionsAI, LLC ("OptionsAI" or "We" or "Us"), the owner of Options.ai website ("Website"), recognizes the importance of protecting the privacy of its users and of handling non-public information with care. Accordingly, we have established the following Policy.

Updates

We may update this Policy at our discretion from time to time by posting a new version on our Website. You should check our Website occasionally to ensure any changes made are suitable for you. You will be informed of any significant changes made to the Privacy Policy.

Current version of our Privacy Policy was modified on October 10, 2018.

Confidentiality and Security of Personal Information

We maintain appropriate physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect the security and confidentiality of your nonpublic personal information. We educate our employees about the terms of this Policy and the importance of visitor and user privacy. We restrict access to your nonpublic personal information to those employees and others who need to know that information in order to maintain and enhance certain features of our Website.

Information We Collect

Collecting information from you is essential to our ability to provide you with certain features of our Website and for us to continually improve such features. The following is the type of information that we collect:

- Information about your visits, usage and activity on our Website
- Your email address and username if you decide to use certain features of our Website
- The email address of third parties with whom you may decide to share certain features of our Website
- Additional information that you may decide to share with us which is not mandatory

How We Collect and Use Information

If you decide to use certain features of our Website or to become a registered user, you will be required to provide your email address. You may also choose to provide the email address of a third party for the purposes of sharing certain features of our site.

Cookies

Like many websites, we use "cookie" technology to collect additional website usage data and to improve certain features of the site. A cookie is a small data file that we transfer to your computer's hard disk. We do not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information. We may use both session cookies and persistent cookies to better understand how you interact with our website, to monitor aggregate usage by our users and web traffic routing on the site, to serve ads on the site that are tailored to your interests, and to improve the website. A session cookie enables certain features of the website and is deleted from

your computer when you disconnect from or leave the site. A persistent cookie remains after you close your browser and may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to the website. Persistent cookies can be removed by following your web browser help file directions. Most Internet browsers automatically accept cookies. You can instruct your browser, by editing its options, to stop accepting cookies or to prompt you before accepting a cookie from the websites you visit.

Log Files

Like most websites, we use web server log files. Records in our log files include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser types, internet service providers (ISP's), referring pages, exit pages, platform types, and date/time stamps. We use web server log files to administer the site, to provide broad traffic information for site planning purposes, and to ensure that any terms of usage are being adhered to. IP addresses are not tied to personally identifiable information in our web server log files.

Third Party Service Providers

We engage certain trusted third parties to perform functions and provide services to us, including, without limitation, hosting, maintenance and data analytics. We will share your personal information with these third parties, but only to the extent necessary to perform these functions and provide such services, and only pursuant to binding contractual obligations requiring such third parties to maintain the privacy and security of your data. These services may use cookies and other techniques to help us analyze how users interact with the website. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the website (including your IP address) may be transmitted to and stored by the third party. They may use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the site, compiling reports on website activity for us and providing other services relating to website activity and Internet usage. These third parties may also transfer this information to other third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on their behalf. By using the Website, you consent to our use of third parties in the manner and for the purposes set out above.

Except as otherwise stated in this Privacy Policy, we will not, without your permission, sell, publish, or share your personal information to third parties for their marketing purposes.

Notifications and Direct Marketing

On certain occasions we may send you announcements relating to our website or for requests for feedback. Users can refuse to receive such messages in the future by clicking unsubscribe in one of the messages.

Categories of Information We Disclose and to Whom

Except for the purposes described in this Policy, we do not disclose any information about our users or former users to anyone. We do not sell your personal information to third parties.

We reserve the right, in our sole discretion, to share or disclose your personal information with law enforcement, government officials, and other third parties if we establish that such disclosure is necessary to comply with the law. This includes, but is not limited to:

- responding to subpoenas, court orders, or a legal process;
- investigating, preventing, defending against, or taking other action regarding any of our Terms and Conditions or the security of our website;
- responding to claims that any posting or other content violates the rights of third parties;
- as otherwise required by any applicable law.

User Rights

You have the right to refuse to use our website and to delete your registered user profile, if applicable. You may also object to our processing of your data for the purposes of direct marketing and for notifications or requests relating to our website. This can be done by clicking unsubscribe in the message.
